### Gordon Oakes Red Bear Student Centre

5 Campus Dr.  
Douglas Cardinal, the renowned architect of Métis and Blackfoot heritage, designed this to be an inclusive, intercultural gathering place for the whole U of S community. From the curving Tyndall stone exterior to the grand central lobby, the building incorporate many symbols of First Nations culture. *Disabled access, on duty staff, street/paid parking.*

### Little Stone School House

College Dr.  
Built by stonemason Sandy Marr, of the Marr Residence, in 1887 this building was Saskatoon's first public school. Originally called Victoria School it hosted up to 40 pupils as well as being the centre of the pioneer community. An early example of heritage conservation it was named a national historic site in 1967. *Partial disabled access, no washroom, street parking, on duty staff.*

### National Research Council

110 Gymnasium Place  
See where the future of agriculture is being developed today. World-class biotechnology research is the main activity carried on in this 1948 building. Scientists here, working with researchers at the University of Manitoba and Agriculture Canada developed canola in the 1960s and '70s. *Disabled access, washrooms, street and paid parking, on duty staff.*

### Baitur Rahmat Mosque

Highway 16 and Boychuk Dr.  
Learn about the Islamic faith at Saskatchewan's largest mosque that opened in 2017. The building features a minaret and dome. Inside there is a large prayer hall, meeting rooms and a full-size gymnasium. *Disabled access, washrooms, on duty staff, free parking.*
